2. Current & Upcoming Projects
  - a) Rockwell Avenue Basketball Court Lighting Project – Finalized contract with Westin & Sampson for scope and bidding of Rockwell Avenue basketball court lighting. Anticipate work to be completed in late spring/early summer.
  - b) Town Signage & Wayfinding Project – Entered into phase 2 contract with KMA Design for signage implementation. Currently we plan on the project to be completed late spring/early summer of 2017.
  - c) Alvin & Beatrice Wood Human Services Building – New construction project passed referendum and has gone to building committee. The building committee is scheduled to meet every other week beginning in January 2017.
  - d) Bloomfield Bikeway/Walkway Connectivity Design – The focus group support and recommend to the town to develop a master plan for a town-wide “Complete Streets Plan”.
  - e) Wintonbury Hills Golf Course – Discussions with Westin & Sampson for scope work for the driving range structures. There was an on-site meeting scheduled for December 6.
  - f) Lisa Lane Phase 2 project – 2016 DOAG Viability grant was submitted for repairs to the operations building and new construction of a cold storage building for the farmers produce.

- A. Capital Improvements Budget – The 2017/2018-2021/2022 Capital Improvement Program Budget was presented to the Committee. The 17/18 budget includes Lisa Lane farm improvements, WHGC improvements, LaSalette Park improvements, Complete Streets Plan, and Water Splashpad totaling \$567,550. The remaining

four years include Oliver Filley Stone House Interior work, Pool House Repairs, Pershing Park Revitalization Plan, and Wilcox Park Shelter for a full 5 year total of \$3,103,750.
