COMMITTEE ON COMMITTEES SUBCOMMITTEE

There was a regular meeting of the above referenced subcommittee held on Monday, March 17, 2014 at 6:30 p.m. in Conference Room #5, Bloomfield Town Hall, 800 Bloomfield Avenue, Bloomfield, CT.

Consider and Take Action Regarding Appointments to Boards and Commissions

Ms. Marguerite Phillips, Town Clerk updated the committee regarding the following vacancies:

Ethics Commission – 2 Alternate seats are vacate, 1 Republican and 1 Democrat with 4 year term beginning with date of appointment July 1, 2014 – June 30, 2018.

The committee discussed and recommended appointments to the following boards and commissions:

Bloomfield Recreation Committee

It was noted that no Republicans are appointed to this committee. Councilor Washington will contact Mr. Bob Ike, Chair of the Bloomfield Republican Town Committee for any recommendations.

Greater Hartford Flood Commission

It was moved by Deputy Mayor Gamble, seconded by Councilor Washington and voted unanimously to recommend appointment of Mr. Barry Berson to the full Town Council.

Advisory Commission on Services to People with Disabilities

Councilor Washington will contact Sharon Drexler, Chair of this committee to inquire about recommendations of members for appointment.

Fair Rent Commission

It was moved by Deputy Mayor Gamble, seconded by Councilor Washington to recommend the appointment of the entire board of the Fair Rent Commission. The term of office is one year from the effective date of appointment. Councilor Washington sent Mr. Ike a notice for recommendation of a Republican candidate to fill

a vacancy. The Bloomfield Republic Town Committee will meet on March 18, 2014 to discuss recommendations.
