**COMMITTEE ON COMMITTEES**

**It was moved by Councilor DeLorenzo seconded by Councilor Washington and voted unanimously to recommend Mr. John Giles to the full Town Council to fill a vacancy with the Bloomfield Housing Authority.**

**Consider and Take Possible Action regarding Appointments to the Youth Adult Council and Juvenile Review Board**

Councilor DeLorenzo inquired about the necessity to identify party affiliation for both the Youth Adult Council and Juvenile Review Board. Councilor DeLorenzo did not have any recommendations for additional appointments.

It was noted that current members will continue to serve as designated.

*Fair Rent Commission*

Deputy Mayor Hypolite informed the committee that Mr. Joe Wactowski has requested to resign from the Fair Rent Commission. It was recommended by the Republican Town Committee to appointment Mr. Thomas Moore to fill this vacancy of a Republican seat.

It was moved by Councilor Gamble, seconded by Councilor Washington and voted unanimously to recommend Mr. Thomas Moore to the full Town Council to fill a vacancy with the Fair Rent Commission, subject to receipt of resignation letter from Mr. Joe Wactowski in the Town Clerk's Office.
