### ***Notice!*** *New Pilot Program Launches July 7: Expanded Hours for In-Person Services*

Starting July 7, 2025, the Town of Bloomfield is launching a 60-day pilot program designed to make it easier for you to access in-person services at Town Hall and the Human Services Center.

What's changing?

- Earlier Start: Doors will open at 8:30 AM every weekday, allowing you to take care of business before your day gets busy.
- Extended Tuesdays: Offices will remain open until 6:00 PM every Tuesday to better

accommodate those who need evening hours.

This pilot is focused on providing greater flexibility, increased convenience, and improved service for our community. Please note that core services such as Public Works, Police, and the Library will continue to operate on their regular schedules.
