BLOOMFIELD CEEC SHRED & ELECTRONICS RECYCLING DAY WAS A GREAT SUCCESS

Bloomfield's Conservation, Energy, and Environment Committee (CEEC) held its fall community shred and electronics recycling event on Saturday, November 3rd. The event was at Bloomfield High School for the first time since Town Hall, the usual location, was busy due to Early Voting.

The semi-annual event is an

opportunity for Bloomfield residents to have confidential material shredded at no cost and to easily recycle household electronics and batteries. Town staff, youth, and CEEC volunteers run the event.

Once again the event was a great success. We shredded approximately 11,100 pounds of paper and collected 4,012 pounds of electronics. Along
