What you need to bring:

- ◆ Bring your pet's current Rabies Vaccination Certificate in order to obtain a 3 year rabies vaccine.
- ◆ No proof of previous rabies? Don't worry a 1 year rabies vaccine will be given.
- ◆ Bring \$20.00 cash. No checks, debit cards or credit cards will be accepted.

Dog licensing for Simsbury & Farmington only

- ◆ Proof of current rabies vaccination.
- ◆ Proof of spay/neuter.
- ◆ Cash (exact change please).
- ◆ \$8 spayed/neutered or \$19 intact male/female.
- ◆ **Per CGS Sec 22-338, a \$1 late fee per month, per dog will be added if you license your dog after June 2025 .**
