The Matching Payment Program (MPP) can lower the amount you owe on energy bills. For every dollar you pay and every dollar you receive from the Connecticut Energy Assistance Program (CEAP), Eversource and CNG will subtract a dollar from the amount you owe up to a zero balance.

Bloomfield's Food Bank is available to Bloomfield Residents. Fill out an application and provide proof of Bloomfield residency. There are two visits per month allowed per household. It is open Wednesdays from 1 pm – 3 pm and on Fridays from 11 am – 1 pm **with the exception of June 13 because we are closing at 11:30 am. Please come on 6/12 instead of 6/13. From July 7 – Sept 5th the Friday hours will be 10-noon.** Once a month there is a shopping day, which counts as 1 of your 2 monthly visits. Shopping Day is by appointment only as space is limited. In fairness to everyone, please call on the first business day of each month 860-242-1895 to make an appointment.

TOWN OF BLOOMFIELD SUMMER HOURS PILOT PROGRAM

Beginning July 7, 2025, the Town of Bloomfield will launch a 60-day pilot program to revise in-person hours at **Town Hall** (800 Bloomfield Avenue) and the **Alvin & Beatrice Wood Human Services Center** (330 Park Avenue). These changes are designed with residents in mind to provide more flexible access to services while maintaining overall service availability.

There will be no impact to core services—The Department of Public Works, Bloomfield Police Department, and Bloomfield Public Library will continue operating on their regular schedules.
