RENTER'S REBATE PROGRAM

This rebate is available to Connecticut renters who are 65 years of age or older; or under 65 years of age and receiving social security disability.

Program ends Sept. 30th. If you received a letter stating we needed more documents, please send them in asap!

Maximum Gross Income

Single Person: \$45,200

Married Couple: \$55,100

Required documents:

- 1) your SSA 1099
- 2) 2024 tax return (if one was filed)
- 3) 2024 rent payment history
- 4) 2024 utility payment history
