

ACCEPTABLE HAZARDOUS WASTE: (*partial list*): Oil-based paint, aerosol cans, gasoline, glue, pool chemicals, disinfectants, fluorescent light bulbs, antifreeze, rechargeable batteries. Hazardous collections are conducted by (MDC) The Metropolitan District Commission.

UNACCEPTABLE WASTE: (*partial list*): Ammunition (includes gunpowder), biohazard, business waste, car batteries, cement, electronics, explosives, Freon, ice melt, marine flares, medical waste including needles and syringes, medicines, smoke detectors, tires, used automobile oil and oil filters.

TRASH REMINDER: BAGGED, BOXED OR LOOSE TRASH OUTSIDE OF YOUR CONTAINER WILL NOT BE COLLECTED (see bulk items proper disposal).

Town issued trash and recycling containers are the only authorized containers that will be collected.

Containers may not be refilled and dumped within the same week.

NEED ADDITIONAL CONTAINERS?

There is no charge for your first set of garbage and recycling containers. However, for each additional trash or recycling container requested, there is an \$84.96 fee charged per bin, per fiscal year. For details please call All American Waste: 860-289-7850.

PLEASE NOTE:

- ❖ The **Town of Bloomfield** and **All American Waste** reserve the right to vary routes, collection dates/times, vehicles and drivers.
- ❖ Containers, bulk items, leaf bags and Christmas Trees must be placed curbside by **7:00 a.m. the morning of** or **no sooner than 6:00 p.m. the night before** your collection day.
- ❖ The lids of your containers must open and face toward the street and should be placed at least 3 feet apart from each other for ease of disposing contents.

SPRING LEAF COLLECTION

(3 Weeks)

April 16, 2018 – May 4, 2018

FALL LEAF COLLECTION

(4 Weeks)

Nov. 12, 2018 – Dec. 7, 2018

Leaf bags will be collected on your regular trash collection day during the Fall and Spring collection weeks noted above.

Residents must use biodegradable paper leaf bags for curbside collection.

- Do not place grass or garden clippings in biodegradable bags
- Do not rake leaves to curb
- Do not place leaves in plastic bags
- Do not use non-regulation containers

CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTION

(1 week only)

**Monday, January 22, 2018 through
Friday, January 26, 2018**

Place tree laying down curbside on your collection day

PLEASE DO NOT BAG OR BOX TREE

BULK ITEMS

Bulk items are collected the 3rd full week of each month (a full week begins on a SUNDAY) on your regular trash collection day. Following is a partial list of acceptable bulk items.

ACCEPTABLE BULK ITEMS:

Acceptable Metal & Bulky Items

Metal & regular bulk items must be at curbside on your collection day by 7:00 a.m. Metal items must be stored into a separate pile. Keep items 3 feet from containers. See examples below or call All American Waste.

Examples of Acceptable Bulk Items

Appliance & Metal: (partial list)

- Refrigerator (doors removed for child safety)
- Lawn Mowers (drained of oil and gas)
- Hot Water Heaters, Microwaves, Toilets
- Bicycles, Swing-sets (dismantled)

Furniture: (partial list)

- Sofa (if sleeper, remove frame & mattress)
- Mattress, head & foot boards
- Ironing Boards, Bookcases/Shelving
- Carpet and padding, must be rolled and tied no longer than 4 feet

Twigs, Wood and Tires:

- Twig bundles (no large branches)
- Prepared wood (nails REMOVED)
- Tires (must be off the rim)

Trash Items (miscellaneous)

(Place items inside trash container) Water-based paint cans (dried contents), pots (clay & plastic), regular household light bulbs, small toys, cooking pots/pans, utensils, hardcover books.



UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

Electronics

**TVs ARE NO LONGER COLLECTED
Electronics may be dropped off at the
Windsor TRANSFER STATION
(860) 285-1833.**

- Windows & Doors: call All American Waste
- Propane tanks (empty containers may be brought to the Transfer Station)
- All car parts (except tires, see Bulk Items)
- Shingles and siding
- Building materials: sheet rock, concrete, (most materials from a dwelling)
- Tree stumps

RECYCLING ITEMS (Partial list) (In Blue Container)

DO NOT BE PLACE IN TRASH BINS

- Metal / Glass food containers (clean, remove labels)
- Gable tip milk & juice cartons (cleaned)
- Corrugated cardboard (flatten for best fit)
- Plastic food containers #1 through #7
- White paper, newspaper, and magazines
- **TELEPHONE BOOKS, hardcover books, hard plastics such as buckets and laundry baskets are NOW ACCEPTABLE IN THE BLUE BINS**

DO NOT PLACE CONTAINERS ON THE ROAD

ALL CONTAINERS NEED TO BE REMOVED FROM CURBSIDE WITHIN 24 HOURS OF THE COLLECTION DAY - PER ORDINANCE NO. 90-3, 12-10-90
